1.	Is accommodation provided?	No.
2.	When will the teams receive their invitation letter?	Invitation letter together with distribution list have been uploaded in the Robocon Malaysia official website.
3.	Will rings be provided for training purposes?	Due to pending purchasing approval and time constraint (up to this date), we are sorry to inform that we will not be able to provide the teams with any rings for training purposes. Instead, we recommend the teams to purchase and self-construct the rings for training purposes. The purchasing details and the instructions on how to construct the rings are given on the website under tab GAMES > GAME FIELD & EQUIPMENT SPECIFICATIONS > STEPS TO CONSTRUCT RINGS. We truly apologise for any inconveniences this may have caused.

5.	When will the Robocon Malaysia will sell the rings?	We do not sell the rings.

10.	The number of participants that will receive the cert?	All registered participants
11.	Will the source to buy the rings be provided so that we can buy our own?	Yes. The information is now available at the following tab GAMES > GAME FIELD AND EQUIPMENT SPECIFICATIONS > STEPS TO CONSTRUCT RINGS).
12.	3 crews + 3 operators, does that mean only 6 participating certs will be provided or we can request for more?	Certificates will be provided for all registered participants.
13.	For the accommodation, will the contact person information be shared through the website?	Yes.
14.	May I ask when will the FAQs be published if all inquiries are to be submitted via google form?	As soon as possible.
15.	Will Robocon Malaysia follow ALL rules and FAQs by ABU ROBOCON?	Yes.

16.	Can we know the general time of our game day starting at what time and end at what time?	8 am until 5.30 pm every day except for the 13th. On the 13th, tentative end time is at 1 pm.
17.	If rings not provided, how much time we have during the competition to test the rings	We will consider providing a training space outside the hall during the whole period of the event. You can use that training space to test the rings.
18.	Are food provided for participants?	Food is provided for the main registered members i.e. 3 operators, 3 pit crew members and 1 manager.
19.	Can air compressor be brought to the pit area?	No, the usage of air compressors in the pit area is not allowed due to concerns regarding high current/voltage load. However, the organizer will provide air compressors specifically in the robot check area and training area.
20.*	Is there any specific Whatsapp group for team managers like last year?	Yes, a Whatsapp group will be created for team managers prior to the event week.
21.*	What time is the submission of the paperwork on the 3 rd of June?	The submission for the technical report has been extended to 8 June 2023.
22.*	Can two teams from the same university meet each other during semi-final?	Yes, it is possible.

23.*	How many teams will get through into the next round for each group?	Two teams from each group will move to quarter-final round.
24.*	How to determine the winners from the group match and enter the quarterfinal?	Two teams with the highest marks in each group will move to quarter-final.
25.*	What is the plan for the quarter final? For example, top winner from A meet B?	Match schedules will be uploaded on the website.
26.*	Just to confirm again, the technical report submission date was extended to 8 June?	Yes.
